## **First Login**

#### **Google Classroom**

Google Classroom is part of the G Suite for Education set of tools that is designed to help teachers and students communicate, manage paperless assignments, and stay organized.

#### **First Login**

Go to **classroom.google.com** and sign in using the username (yourname@cti-school.com) you received from CTI. You can follow the steps shown in the video attached <u>here</u> for your first log in. Use the class codes you receive from your teachers to join your classes. Alternatively, Google Classroom can be accessed using mobile apps (**Android and iOS**).

## Join a Class with a Class Code

1. Click the + on the top right of the page to Join Class.



2. Enter the Class Code given to you by your teacher, and click Join.
